An alternative method is to carefully plan and be prepared for the things we are aware of that might possibly cause us some short-term discomfort, or risk to our life, health, or property.

This defines the need for emergency preparedness. Eliminate the fear by taking time to document things that will assist family and friends to help you in an emergency. List names and phone numbers, medications, physician names and phone numbers, locations of valuables, etc.
